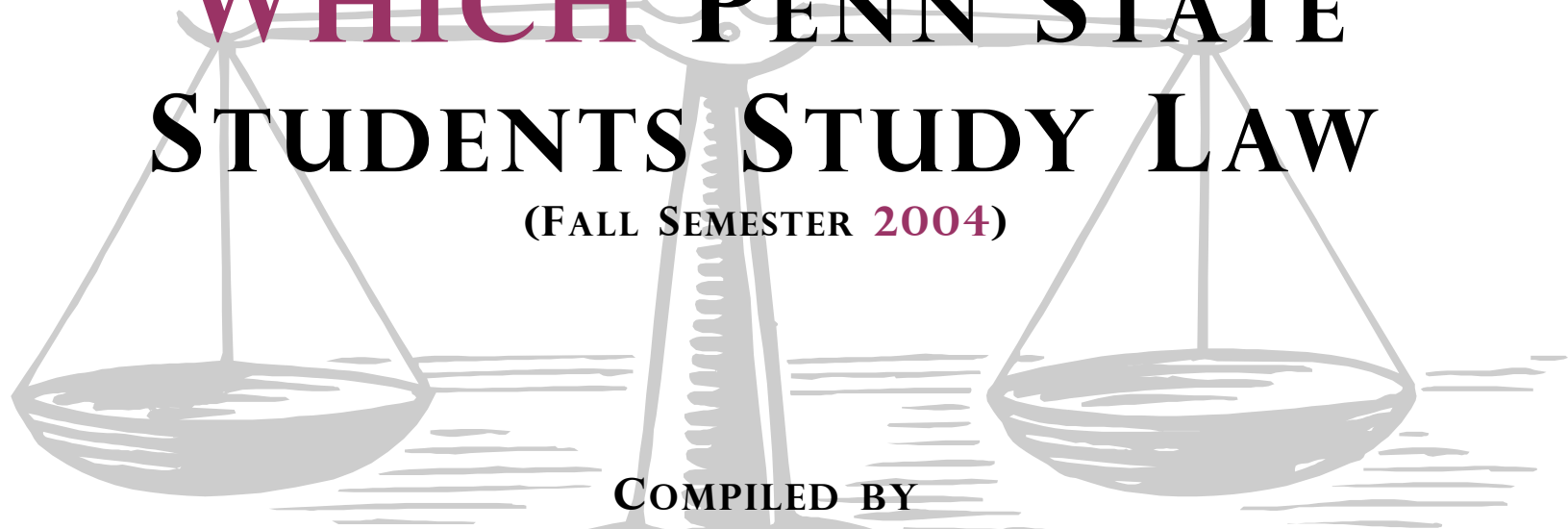

It shows which PSU students applied, were accepted, and matriculated in law schools fall 2004. The GPA and LSAT score given is the mean for the group of applicants who reported their scores to PSU. An * indicates three or fewer students in the pool and thus no average is given. Only those majors with students applying to law schools are listed. The majors are categorized according to LSAC criteria and do not correspond directly with PSU majors. Majors were self reported by the students.
